

## CA22145 Dissemination Conference Grants

### 1st Call for Applications

Dissemination Conference Grants support the participation of Action participants to high-level conferences organized by a third party, i.e. not organized nor co-organized by the COST Action, to present the work of the Action.

Dissemination Conference Grants will help increase the visibility of the Action in the research community, and will contribute to increasing visibility of the presenter; moreover, it will attract additional participants and stakeholders by facilitating the dissemination of Action results to relevant end-users at high profile Conferences in the field on a topic relevant to the Action.

Dissemination Conference Grants provide contribution for travel, accommodation, and subsistence expenses, registration fee, and printing of scientific posters. Up to EUR 2000 per grantee for face to-face conferences or EUR 500 for virtual conferences can be reimbursed by COST. More information can be found in Annex 2-1.2.2 of the Annotated Rules for COST Actions.

#### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- The Applicant must be a member of a Working Group in the Action GameTable.
- The proposed contribution and its outcomes should be related to the Action MoU objectives.

The conference should be organised by a third party and not the Action.

#### **How to apply:**

Applications for Dissemination Conference Grants are first submitted on the e-COST website.

Upload these supporting documents in the related page on e-COST:

- Dissemination conference grant application (based on e-COST template)
- Copy of the abstract of the accepted oral presentation
- Acceptance (or invitation) letter from the conference organisers
- Certificate of Attendance
- Conference Program
- Other documents required by the Action: CV and short description of how well the proposed conference participation aligns with the scientific goals of the Action as laid out in its Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

**Evaluation:**

- After the submission, the proposals will be evaluated by the Action Grant Awarding Coordinators and the Core Group of the GameTable Network who will assess the scientific merit and budget of the proposals.

The researchers who applied to the call will receive the results of the selection 2 weeks after the submission.

The selected researchers will have to acknowledge the COST Action in their final contribution (if applicable) to the conference.
