





CA22145 Dissemination Conference Grants Call for Applications- 2nd Grand Period

Dissemination Conference Grants fund Action participants to attend and present their work at high-level conferences that are not organised or co-organized by the COST Action.

Dissemination Conference Grants will help increase the visibility of the Action in the research community, and will contribute to increasing visibility of the presenter; moreover, it will attract additional participants and stakeholders by facilitating the dissemination of Action results to relevant end-users at high profile Conferences in the field on a topic relevant to the Action.

Financial details:

Dissemination Conference Grants offer financial support to participants, covering travel, accommodation, subsistence, registration fees, and poster printing expenses.

The maximum reimbursement is EUR 2,000 for in-person conferences and EUR 500 for virtual conferences. For further details, please refer to Annex 2-1.2.2 of the <u>Annotated Rules for COST Actions.</u>

Eligibility Criteria:

- The Applicant must be a member of a Working Group within the Action GameTable.
- The proposed contribution and its outcomes must align with the Action's Memorandum of Understanding objectives.

How to apply:

Applications for Dissemination Conference Grants are first submitted on the <u>e-COST website</u>. To apply for a Dissemination Conference Grant, follow these steps:

- 1. Submit your application through the e-COST website.
- 2. Upload the following supporting documents:
 - Completed Dissemination Conference Grant application form (using the e-COST template).
 - Copy of the abstract for your accepted oral presentation.
 - Acceptance (or invitation) letter from the conference organisers, printed on official letterhead and signed.
 - Conference program (if available).







- A statement explaining how your presentation aligns with the Action's Science Communication Plan and its expected impact.
- o Your current CV.

Deadline: This is an open call covering the whole 2nd Grant Period.

Evaluation:

- Proposals will be evaluated by the Action Grant Awarding Coordinators and the Core Group of the GameTable Network based on scientific merit and budget.
- Applicants will be notified of the selection results within one month of submission.
- Applications for conferences covered in the first Grant Period will be assessed depending on the quality and the potential impact for increasing GameTable's visibility.

Post-Conference Requirements:

In order to receive the DCG, grantees will be asked to provide and upload on e-COST:

- Dissemination Conference Report based on e-COST template. (Reports must be different for all participants even if they co-presented the Action at the same conference)
- Official Conference Program showing the oral presentation of the grantee.
- Certificate of Attendance.

Note: Selected researchers must acknowledge the COST Action in their final conference proceedings.
