





CA22145 Young Researchers and Innovators Conference Grant Call for Applications- 3rd Grand Period

YRI Conference Grants are aimed at supporting Young Researchers and Innovators participating at high-level conferences fully organised by a third party. The grantee receives support for attending and presenting their work (poster/oral presentation) aiming to establish a strong network and increase their visibility in the research community.

COST defines a Young Researcher or Innovator as someone <u>under the age of 40</u>. You can still benefit from measures introduced for Young Researchers and Innovators during the duration of the year you turn 40.

Financial details:

YRI Conference Grants offer financial support to participants, covering travel, accommodation, subsistence, registration fees, and poster printing expenses.

The maximum reimbursement is EUR 2.500 for in-person conferences and EUR 500 for virtual conferences. For further details, please refer to Annex 2-1.2.3 of the <u>Annotated Rules for COST Actions</u>.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The applicant must be below 40 years of age.
- The Applicant must be a member of a Working Group within the Action GameTable.
- The proposed contribution and its outcomes must align with the Action's Memorandum of Understanding objectives.

How to apply:

Applications for the YRI Conference Grant must be submitted on the <u>e-COST website</u>, by uploading the following supporting documents:

- Completed YRI Conference Grant application form using the e-COST template. This will include statements explaining how your presentation aligns with the Action's Science Communication Plan and its expected impact.
- Generated YRI grants COST form, with details of the conference, the dates and the requested amount.
- The acceptance (or invitation) letter from the conference organisers, printed on official letterhead and signed.
- Copy of the abstract of the accepted poster or oral presentation.

Your current CV

Deadline: This is an open call covering the whole 3rd Grant Period. From November 2025 to October 2026.

Evaluation:

- Proposals will be evaluated by the Action Grant Awarding Coordinators and the Core Group of the Game Table Network based on scientific merit and budget.
- Applicants will be notified of the selection results within one month of submission. If applications are urgent, please contact the GA Coordinators.

Post-Conference Requirements:

- YRI Conference Report based on e-COST template.
- Official Conference Program showing the oral presentation of the grantee.
- Certificate of Attendance.
- Copy of the given presentation. This must acknowledge the Gametable Action. You can refer to the Action code CA22145, and include the relevant logos in your presentation's slides.

Note: Selected researchers must acknowledge the COST Action in their final conference proceedings. (if applicable).
