June 30 to July 3, 2025, at the University of Glasgow

Dear Colleagues,

To all interested parties we have opened the call for student application for the *Summer School Mathematics in Games* held from June 30 to July 3, 2025, at the University of Glasgow. This summer school is part of the <u>Game Table</u> COST action CA22145, and part of the workgroup of the same name.

There are 12 fully funded studentships, this means travel and accommodation costs (at Glasgow University Residences) as well as a daily allowance reimbursed after the event as well as 10 additional self-funded vacancies.

The lecture plan will be an introduction to the following topics:

- Game Theory
- Combinatorial Game Theory
- Mathematical Analysis of Games
- Games in Mathematics Education;
- History of Recreational Mathematics and Mathematical Games.

The main audience of this training school are young and potential researchers (promising undergrad-, graduate, and, post-graduate students), but any well founded interested scholar is welcome to apply, with precedence to members of the COST Action.

Applications are done by filling out and submitting this <u>form here</u>, no later than March 31, 2025. We aim to give you the result of our vetting by mid-April so people can commit to travel plans, by mid-May.
